

Pieced Block 6 (July 2013)

Angles

- Fabric A – One (1) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " square
- Fabric B – One (1) $6\frac{1}{4}$ " square
- Fabric C – Two (2) $10\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- Fabric D – Two (2) $10\frac{1}{4}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " strips
- Cut the A and B squares into quarters diagonally (you will have two A and B triangles left over which can be used in another block)
- Cut 45 degree triangles from each end of each of the C and D strips to make 4 trapezoids (note this may need trimming later)

Construction:

Sew the block, using the diagram as a guide, starting by creating the 4 larger triangles. If necessary, trim the edges to make a smooth edge to join the 4 triangles into a large square.
