

Block #6

Fabric #2

- Print 1 - 2 squares 3" x 3"
4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (center 4-patch)
- Print 2 - 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4 1/2"

Fabric #3

- Print 1 - 2 squares 3" x 3"
4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"
2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (center 4-patch)
- Print 2 - 4 rectangles 2 1/2" x 4

Fabric #4

- Print 1 - 4 squares 3" x 3" (for HST draw a diagonal line on back of squares)

A. Make 8 HST (half-square triangles) units using the 3" squares:

1. Draw a diagonal line on the back of all Fabric #4 squares.
2. Layer the 3" Fabric #2 & #3 squares with Fabric #4 squares
3. Sew a 1/4" seam on both sides of the drawn line.
4. Cut on drawn line creating a total of 8 HST (half-square triangles)
5. Trim to 2 1/2" square

B. Make 4 4-patch blocks using HST's created in step A.

1. 2 blocks combine matching Fabric #2, Print 1 with corresponding HST's
2. 2 blocks combine matching Fabric #3, Print 1 with corresponding HST's
3. Trim to 4 1/2" square



C. Make center 4-patch with Fabric #2, Print 2 and Fabric #3, Print 2



D. Sew 2 rectangles to make a square using Fabric #2 & Fabric #3

E. Complete 9 patch block using all 4 1/2" squares to create 12 1/2" block.
