How to participate:

- Review all instructions/criteria, application and submission information.
- Select one Route 66 attraction (past or current) (can be physical or scenic attraction) that
 you'd most like to work on first come first served (so please provide 2nd and 3rd choices).
 We'd like to have all 8 states represented in the exhibit. A list of locations/attractions that
 have already been selected is available email whoob@aol.com.
- Submit your application to participate.
- Receive confirmation of your Route 66 attraction choice.
- Receive invitation to the private FB page created for this project.
- Have fun and create art!!!!
- Submit form, photos of finished work, and the \$20.00 entry fee no later than April 15, 2024.
- Agree your piece will be part of traveling exhibit 2024 2027 (pieces will be returned to you
 after completion of exhibition schedule)

Rules/Criteria:

- Finished size of your piece MUST be 24" x 24" square.
- Faced finish (not binding) using black/dark backing (backing must not show when viewing from front)
- Any techniques and materials are allowed, must adhere to the definition of a quilt, i.e., must be three layers stitched together somewhere noticeable on front and back, must include noticeable fabric/textile of some kind
- No copyrighted images, unless you provide specific written permission
- Nothing loose, flapping, hanging, sharp, protruding beyond edges, or higher than 1/4" on front. (We need to be able to easily/safely stack pieces for transport/shipping.)
- Standard hanging sleeve (4" with 1/2" give, 4" gap in center or agree cut may be made to allow for gallery hanging systems)
- Entries must be free of pet hair and be odor-free. Entries with pet hair, odor, or dirty will not be accepted.
- Label attached to back (see sample)
- Submission no later than April 15, 2024.
- Delivery no later than May 31, 2024.
