

# Folded Star

**Fabric:** One 8" square.

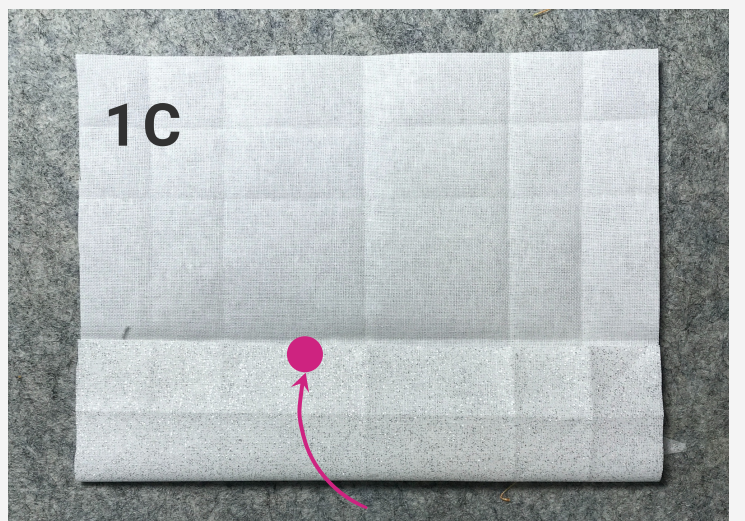
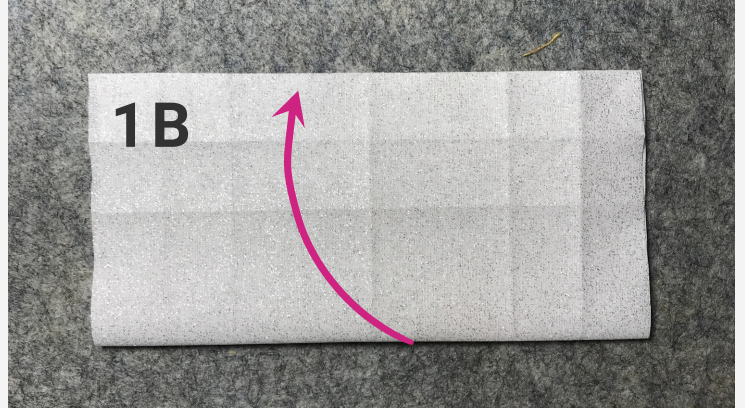
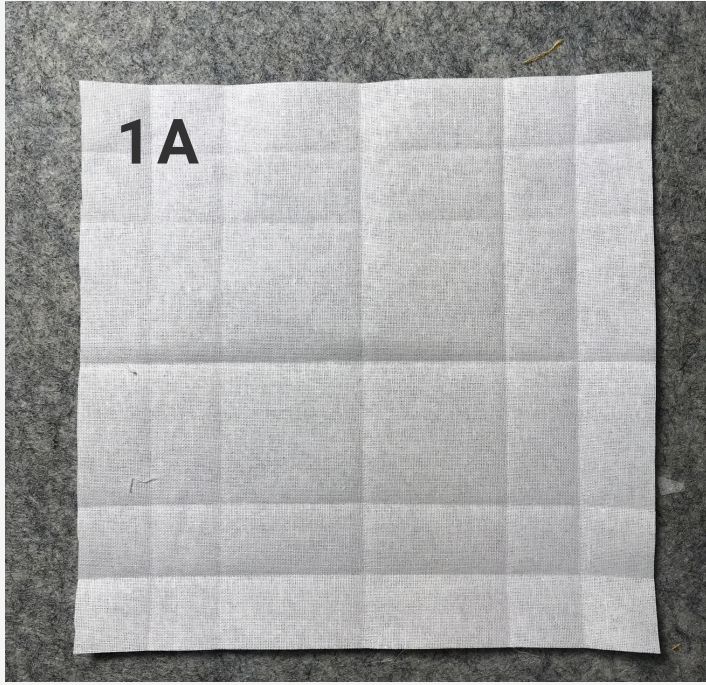
This design can be sewn into ¼ seams without adding bulk.

## 1

### PRE-CREASING

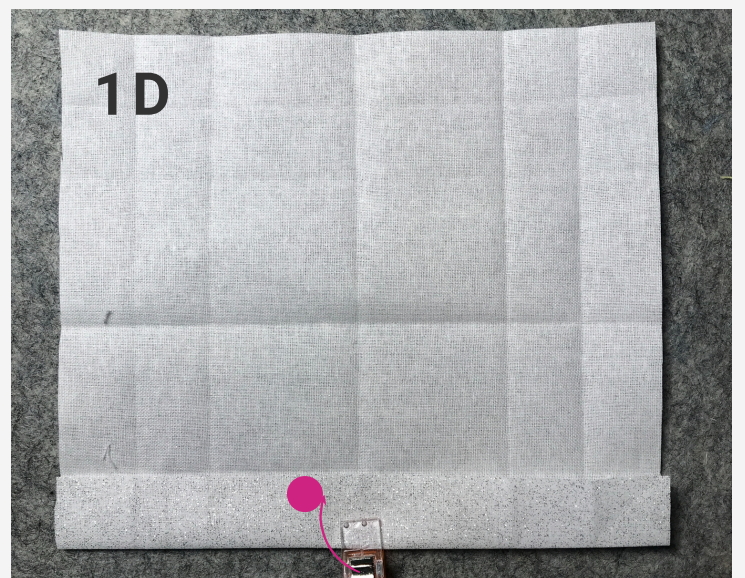
**1A.** Photo on the left shows the entire square pre-creased.

**1B.** Wrong side facing up, fold square in half, then unfold.



**1C.** Fold bottom edge up to first fold, which is the half fold fabric crease. Unfold.

**1D.** Fold the bottom edge up to second fold, which is the quarter fold crease. Unfold.



## 2

### FORM BOX

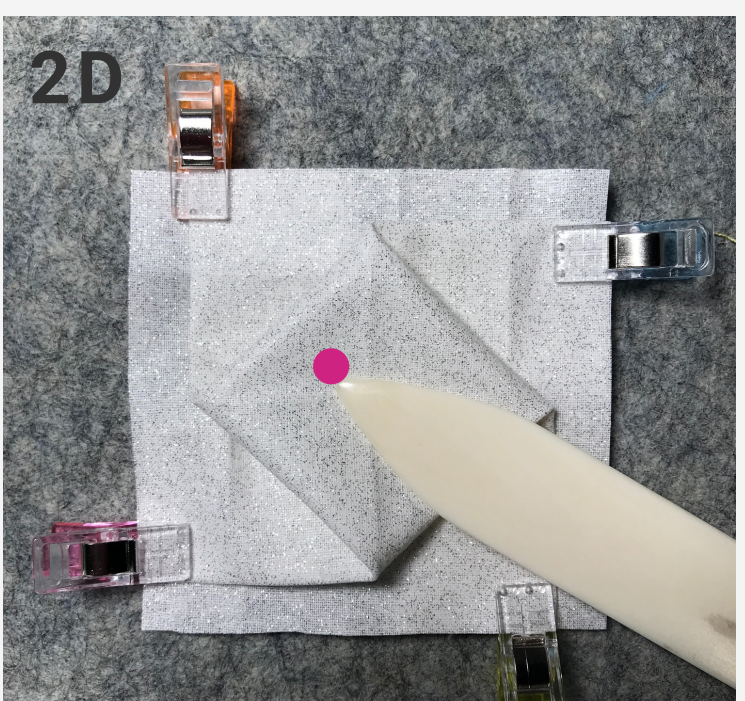
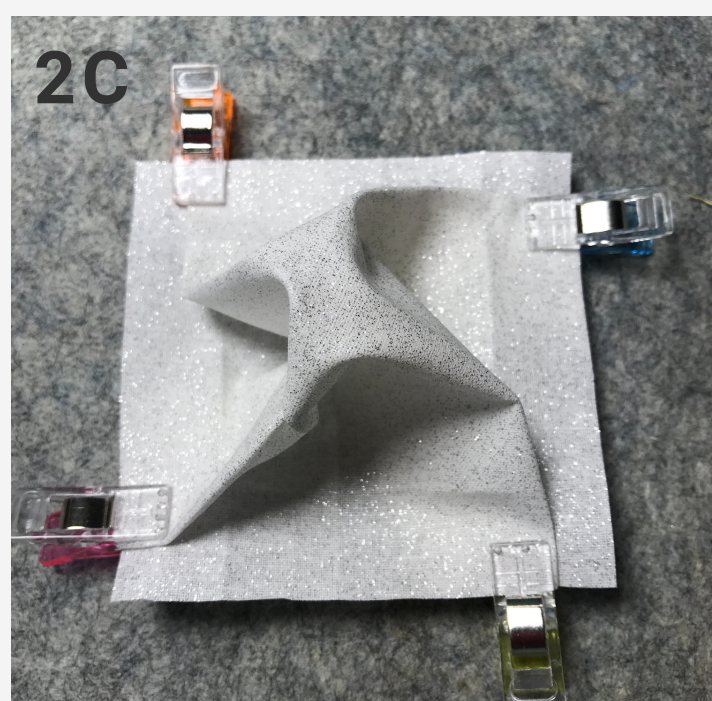
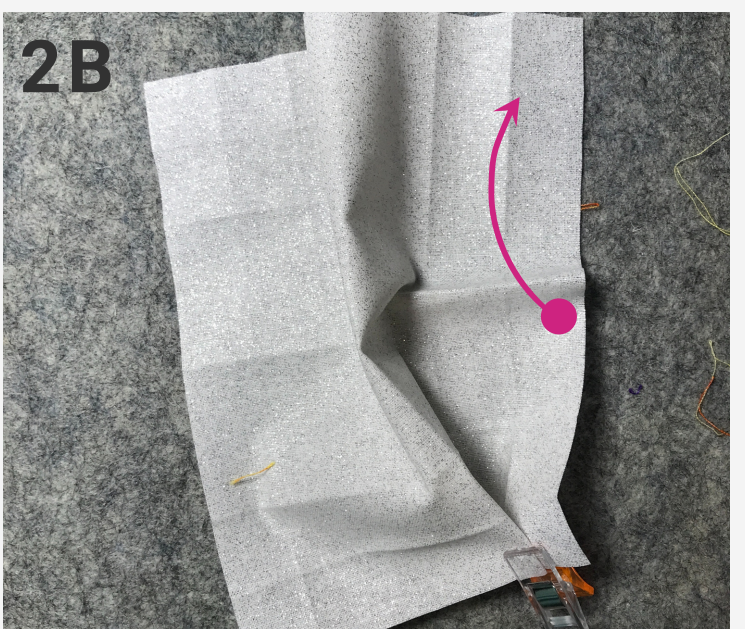
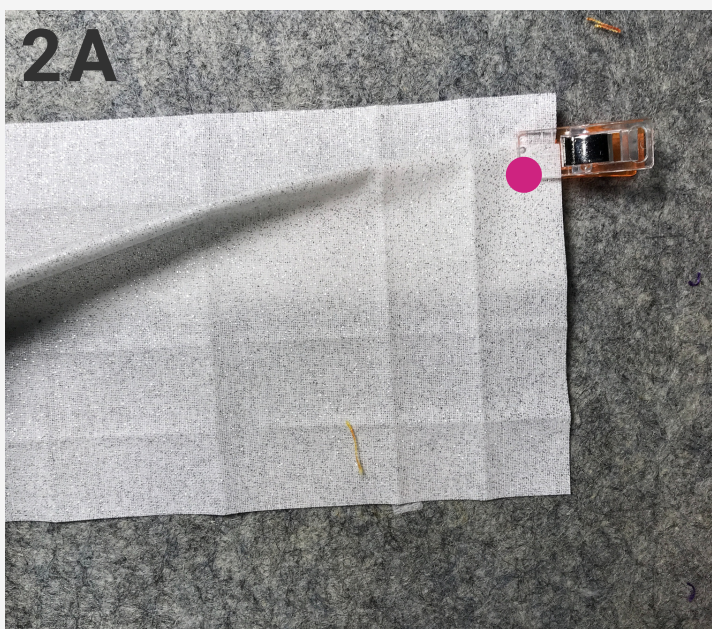
**Flip fabric over to front side.**

**2A.** Bring halfway fold to top creased fold. Add clip to hold the fold to the base.

**2B.** Turn square clockwise. Bring halfway fold on the right to the top creased fold.

**2C.** Fold remaining two sides, turning clockwise in the same way. Add clips to hold.

**2D.** Push twisted fabric to the base and form a diamond. Press with iron.





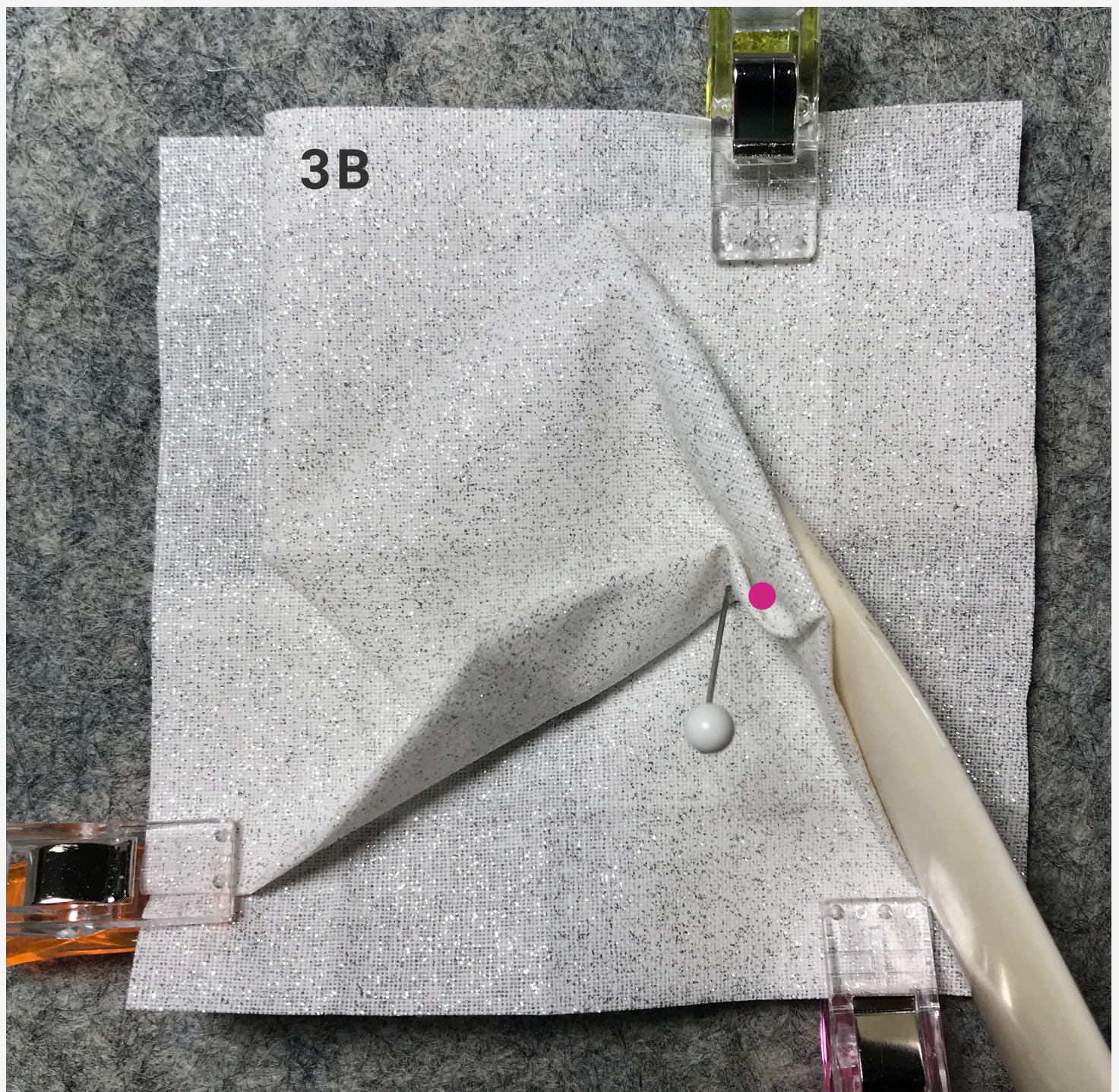
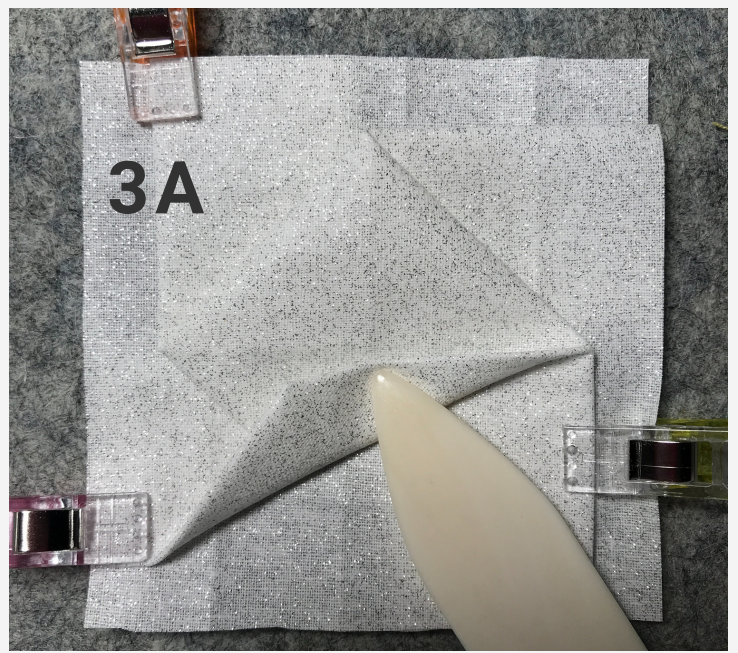

## FORM CORNER TRIANGLES

3A. Fold right bottom edge of diamond to the halfway creased fold. Clip to hold.

3B. Turn counterclockwise and do the same fold to each diamond edge.

You will need to open up the previous edge just a bit to fold under the next fold.

## FINISHING

Tack at pink dots from underneath the base to the inside fabric, careful to hide stitches.

## PIECING

This block can be sewn like other quilt blocks. Adjust and fit the edges of the base to the piecing units. Due to the fold on each edge, the edges aren't stable until you baste them or sew them into a seam.
